During I/ITSEC 2009, Calytrix Technologies and TerraSim, Inc will demonstrate correlation between eSim Games' *Steel Beasts Professional* and constructive simulations such as JointSAF and OneSAF. Calytrix will show the correlation in its booth (1040) while TerraSim demos the capabilities of its new Steel Beasts export plug-in in its booth (1229).

Steel Beasts Pro is a vehicle centric simulation of combined arms combat tactics that models the gunner's, commander's and driver's positions of various armored fighting vehicles. At I/ITSEC 2006, eSim Games shared first place for the People's Choice Award of the Serious Games Challenge with its presentation of Steel Beasts Pro.

Calytrix's *LVC Game* provides bidirectional DIS/HLA interconnectivity and other services to Steel Beasts Pro to permit its use in distributed LVC simulation environments. Though Steel Beasts Pro and LVC Game have been in combined use for several years, until now customers had to develop Steel Beasts Pro and SAF terrain databases independently, with results lacking critically-needed correlation among diverse formats. Now, TerraSim's *TerraTools®* simultaneously produces terrain maps for Steel Beasts Pro and other constructive simulation formats, assuring the required correlation.

TerraSim's Steel Beasts Pro exporter plug-in is in development for future release in early 2010. It extends TerraTools' impressive range of capabilities to export 3D terrain databases correlated for both visual simulation and semi-automated forces (SAF) applications of constructive simulation.
